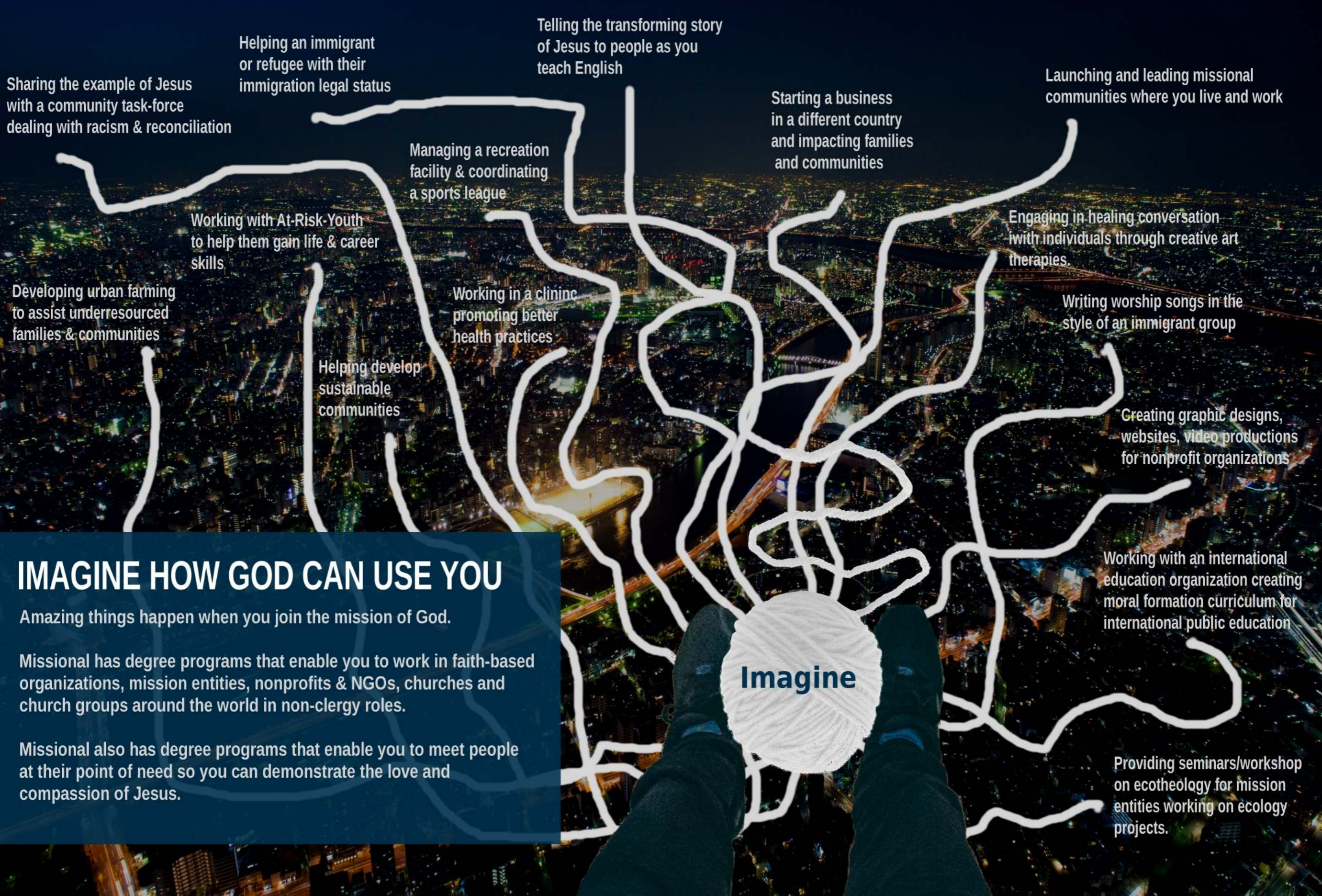

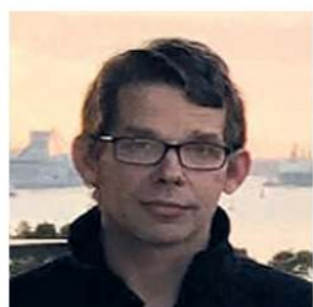

1 MARVIN EANS [USA]

An expert in visual graphics and design, Marvin Eans, MFA, has years of experience applying graphic design concepts in local church ministry as well as serving the needs of missionaries. He leads students to impact culture through design and media.

2 TIFFANY COMBS-BOYKIN [USA]

Dean and Professor of Social Ministry and an At-Risk-Youth Specialist, Dr. Tiffany Combs-Boykin combines her Master of Divinity in Evangelism & Missions, Master of Social Work, and PhD in Human Services with her background as a Social Worker, Case Manager, Health Chaplain, US Navy Chaplain, and Assistant Pastor to equip students in applying Christianity in social settings.

3 EHUD GARCIA [BRAZIL]

Approaching missional theology from the perspective of the kingdom of God, Dr. Ehud Garcia uses a missional lens to view the relation between God's kingdom and the "sentness" of every believer. His own pastoral and missional experiences in Canada, Brazil and the USA provide an international and intercultural focus.

4 NOEMI MONTIEL [PARAGUAY]

A veteran Latin American music educator, Dr. Noemi Montiel has trained students in ethnodoxology – applying Latin musicology to Christian worship – in Argentina, Bolivia and Paraguay; and has worked with churches across South America.

5 MAGDALENE NGEVE [CAMEROON]

The study of biodiversity and ecosystems at Vrije Universiteit Brussels, Belgium led Dr. Magdalene Ngeve to research the genetic structure of mangrove populations of the Cameroon Estuary complex and the regional gene flow of *Rhizophora racemosa* in Eastern Atlantic (USA) mangroves.

6 CHRISTO LOMBARD [SOUTH AFRICA]

An advocate for racial reconciliation and moral formation, Dr. Christo Lombard has taught in contexts of conflict in Namibia and South Africa (where he was involved in peace negotiations with the liberation movement SWAPO and the South African government and was co-founder of the Namibia Peace Plan 435 which played an important role in bringing about peace and reconciliation). He has developed moral formation curriculum for public education in both countries and worked alongside Desmond Tutu in promoting peace and social justice in the new South Africa.

7 OLIVIA OWUSU-BOAKYEWAH [GHANA]

An immigrant herself, Dr. Olivia Owusu-Boakyewaah uses her Master of Social Work and doctoral work in gerontology and allied health professions to research the cultural context of Alzheimer's disease among immigrants and refugees.

8 IGNATIUS MEIMARIS [GREECE]

After more than 30 years in the USA, Dr. Ignatius Meimaris returned home to Greece to address the economic issues of business, university and governmental professionals, where he leads the Interbalkan Institute for Educational & Economic Development. The Institute trains Greek business persons to integrate into the global marketplace and serves as a catalyst for economic development.

9 PETER ŠIŠKA [SLOVAKIA]

A distinguished geographer, Dr. Peter Šiška has taught students GIS and remote sensing applied to ecology, sustainable development, palynology, and geomorphology; while he was at West Point he was a chair of Regional Studies in the Center for Language, Culture and Regional Studies and led a project in strategic missile deployment.

10 MA MIN [CHINA]

An international educator, Prof. Ma Min has been both a student and a professor on three continents. While studying at Oxford University (UK), he went back to mainland China and studied the social and cultural contexts of English learning. As an applied linguist, he has taught Chinese, TESOL and language acquisition in Canada, China, USA and the UK.

11 SUNGPIL YOON [KOREA]

Originally from South Korea, Dr. Sungpil Yoon is a geodesist who measures shapes and areas, the exact position of geographical points, and the curvature, shape and dimensions of the earth using global positioning (GPS) and global navigation satellite systems (GNSS) in his work at the US National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA).

12 FERGUS KING [AUSTRALIA]

A Scottish missionary to East Africa who now serves in Australia, Dr. Fergus King applies a socio-historical understanding of the New Testament based on the culture of biblical eras as a framework for reflecting on the Bible, culture and mission.

- *Research*: practice in statistical and/or ethnographic research methods in an applied research project.
- *Thesis*: results of a demonstration project of research that indicates the student's mastery of the program material.

STEP 4: CLAIM YOUR SPOT!

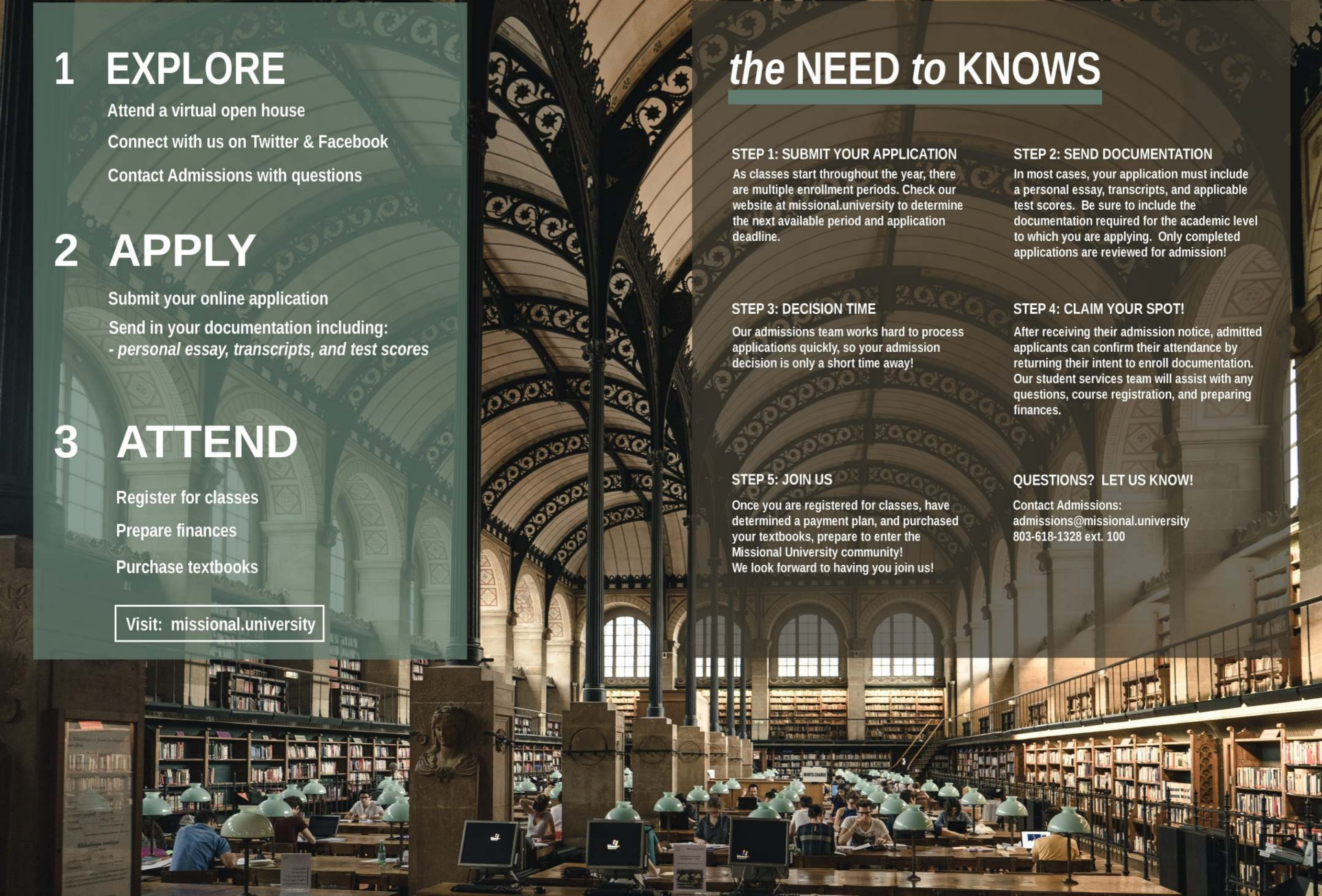
